This candidate will be responsible for managing large and small GIS projects for staff, departments, outside entities, etc. under the direction of the Director of Fiber Management. This will include assisting with the design, development, and maintenance of geospatial applications and data, providing GIS technical support, spatial data analysis and providing general mapping/data requests.

Specific responsibilities include:

- Resolves user complaints, researches issues, answers technical questions and provides assistance with the GIS platform.
- Develops detailed business user requirements, system documentation, workflow procedures and data modeling.
- Basic project management development and implementation.
- Provides business analysis in partnering with departments on appropriate technology
- Develops interfaces to applications.
- Performs database maintenance.
- Provides quality control through testing, correcting errors and database tuning.
- Determines the appropriate business intelligence tools required by departments.
- Queries databases using standard querying tools.
- Troubleshoots and resolves system problems.
- Develops procedural and system documentation.
- Provides ideas and recommendations for better utilization of technology across the organization.
- Coordinates and/or performs testing of system modifications.
- Establishes deadlines and provides ongoing communication of progress to business customers, project team members and vendors to keep projects on track.
- Develops, provides or coordinates system training.
- Coordinates system maintenance, including upgrades and patches as required.
- Assists in system capacity planning.
- Other tasks as assigned by the Director of Fiber Management.

Requirement for the position include:

- Bachelor's Degree in GIS, Geospatial Sciences, or similar technical field, or equivalent of experience. Preference given to completion of a focused GIS certification program.
- 7+ years of experience working with the ESRI GIS Platform with 2 of those years being heavy involvement in the web application development process through the ESRI Portal platform.
- Demonstrated experience in developing applications via the ESRI Portal environment.
- Experience managing projects, developing and maintaining complex systems.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills a must.
- Proven ability to achieve results.
